

Maths:

In our Maths sessions, children will be focusing on the following topics:

- Counting, number writing, ordering
- Addition and subtraction

Children will continue to develop their maths skills using Numbots.

English:

Phonics: Year 1 children will be continuing to learn phonics through daily lessons which begin at 9 o'clock.

Reading: Children will bring home a reading book based on the sounds they know and they need to read daily with an adult. They will also have a story book that they choose from the classroom which can be read by you and shared with your child.

Word Writing: Children will learn to write words by writing the sounds they hear.

Sentence Writing: They will learn to start sentences with a capital letter, use a space between words and finish sentences with a full stop.

Handwriting: Children will practise writing letters from the top using the correct sequence of movements.

Art and Design:

Children will learn to draw a self-portrait and print repeating patterns.

Science:

During this term, the Year 1 topics are:

- My body
- Materials and their properties

This term children will be learning about online safety, exploring the program Purple Mash and learning to code using 2code.
