### UNIFORM

Please ensure that correct, smart uniform is worn.  
A reminder of Summer Uniform is given below:

	Summer Uniform
Girls	Green and white check dress Dark green cardigan with crest White socks Black shoes
Boys	White polo shirt with crest <b>or</b> white school shirt with collar and plain, dark green tie Dark green v-neck jumper with crest Grey shorts or trousers Grey socks Black shoes

A reminder that boys' socks should be grey and that all white polo shirts must have the school logo on, alternatively boys may wear a plain, white button-up shirt **with** a school tie. All jumpers and cardigans should have the school logo please. Children should only wear trainers to school on PE days. Children are not allowed to wear jewellery (including earrings), nail varnish, transfers/tattoos or hair gel for school. Children whose hair is shoulder length or longer should wear it fully tied back, and long fringes should also be clipped back. Please ensure that hair ties and bands are in school colours and not overly flamboyant!

Please do ensure that **all** items of clothing and equipment are clearly and permanently labelled with your child's name. This makes it much easier to reunite lost items with their owners!
