Schools' Partnership tournaments.

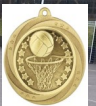
A Sensational Silver!

Many thanks to Miss Devlin and the staff who have been coaching the children in lessons and after-school clubs. Thanks also to the parents and families who came along to support the teams.

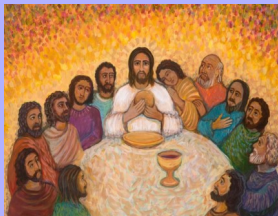
PREPARING FOR EASTER
