PE

P.E Days: Monday and Thursday

Children will learn to:

English

Phonics: Year 1 children will be continuing to learn phonics through daily lessons.

Please help them to practise phonics homework daily to prepare them for the phonics screening during the week of 8th June.

Reading: Children will bring home a reading book based on the sounds they know and they need to read daily with an adult. They will also have a story book that they choose from the classroom which can be read by you and shared with your child.

Word Writing: Children will learn to write words by writing the sounds they hear.

Sentence Writing: They will continue to learn to start sentences with a capital letter, use a space between words and finish sentences with a full stop.

Handwriting: Children will practise writing letters from the top using the correct sequence of movements.

Science

During this term, the Year 1 topics are:

- Making connections: exploring science through stories
- Seasons: spring, summer
- Plants: trees, flowers, growing plants
- Hatching chicks from eggs

History

- Artefacts past and present
- Kings

Computing

- Design an e-book and add animation.
- Navigate a maze and then build your own.

RE

The topics we will cover this term are:

- To the ends of the Earth; the events after Easter
- Dialogue and encounter: understand the connections between Jesus' life and how Christians live today, recognise some features of Judaism

Geography

- Recognise physical and human features
- Draw a sketch map
- Locate China and find out what life is like in Shanghai
