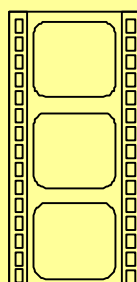


BAGS2SCHOOL

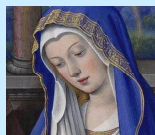


YEAR 3 CLASS MASS
