We will be participating in the Golden Boot Challenge, the biggest school travel competition in the country. This challenge is designed to encourage children, parents and schools to choose sustainable alternatives to the car on school journeys. This year the challenge will be running from the 3rd to the 28th June. During this period, families are encouraged to use an alternative method of transport to the car. You could walk, scoot or cycle to school or, families who live further away, may consider using public transport, organising car-shares or trying "Park and Stride" (i.e. drive to the outskirts of town and then walk in avoiding the town centre traffic congestion) When they arrive at school, the children will record on-line how they travel to school each day and the class with the best results wins the Golden Boot Trophy!
